# Treasurer's report

Financial Report through December 2024

Our receipts dropped \$42,000 from a year ago finishing near to \$230,000. Meanwhile spending on budget items was practically the same at \$269,000 – a little less than last year. This puts us at at spending \$40,000 more than we took in on budget items.

On non-budget lines (primarily the city lease and pastor search) we spent another \$77,000 for a total net impact of minus \$117,000 in the red. This was covered by reducing our savings.

For 2025 our budget items will increase from the October presentation of \$372,000 to roughly \$403,000 to adjust costs for a full-tme pastor. This would mean taking even more out of savings until we turn around our situation. And next year there's the relocation to deal with. But you have to think there's a reason we're still here and a reason we have the means to continue the 200-year mission. Let's be thankful and keep moving forward.
