Gathering together

Every interim is different. And for me, this one has been even more different than usual.

The first and most obvious difference is that my time with you has been more than twice as long as any other interim I have served. Because of that, I have come to enjoy much longer and deeper relationships with you than is typical in an interim. Based on the welcome, care, and relationships I have experienced with

you, I am excited about what is ahead for Paul, Heather, Asher, Qolby, John, and Ava. Please welcome, care for, and love them at least as well as you have me. Good things will happen if you will.

A second difference is that in my time with you we worked together through several challenges that I would characterize as nothing less than "once-in-a-congregational-lifetime" developments. I arrived during the lockdown of the pandemic (and preached to an iPhone in an empty sanctuary for eight months!). My first and best relationships were forged by "virtual" prayer time and Bible study as we interacted with each other on screens. In the months after the pandemic, we went through an extended adjustment period as we waited out the uncertainty of who was coming back and who was not and who was staying the course for the long haul and who was not. And as if a pastor search was not a formidable enough exercise, you voted midstream, first, to put the current property on the market and, second, to sell it to the City of High

Receipts are below last year and so is spending. At the budget level we are just a little worse off than one year ago with a deficit of \$61,000. The lease and non-budget part takes out another \$65,000 which is half of the total shortfall. At least the lease and non-budget things go away when we relocate.

At the time of writing this for the Herald there are a few more days left in the year. We will see if there's a good yearend bump as usual.
